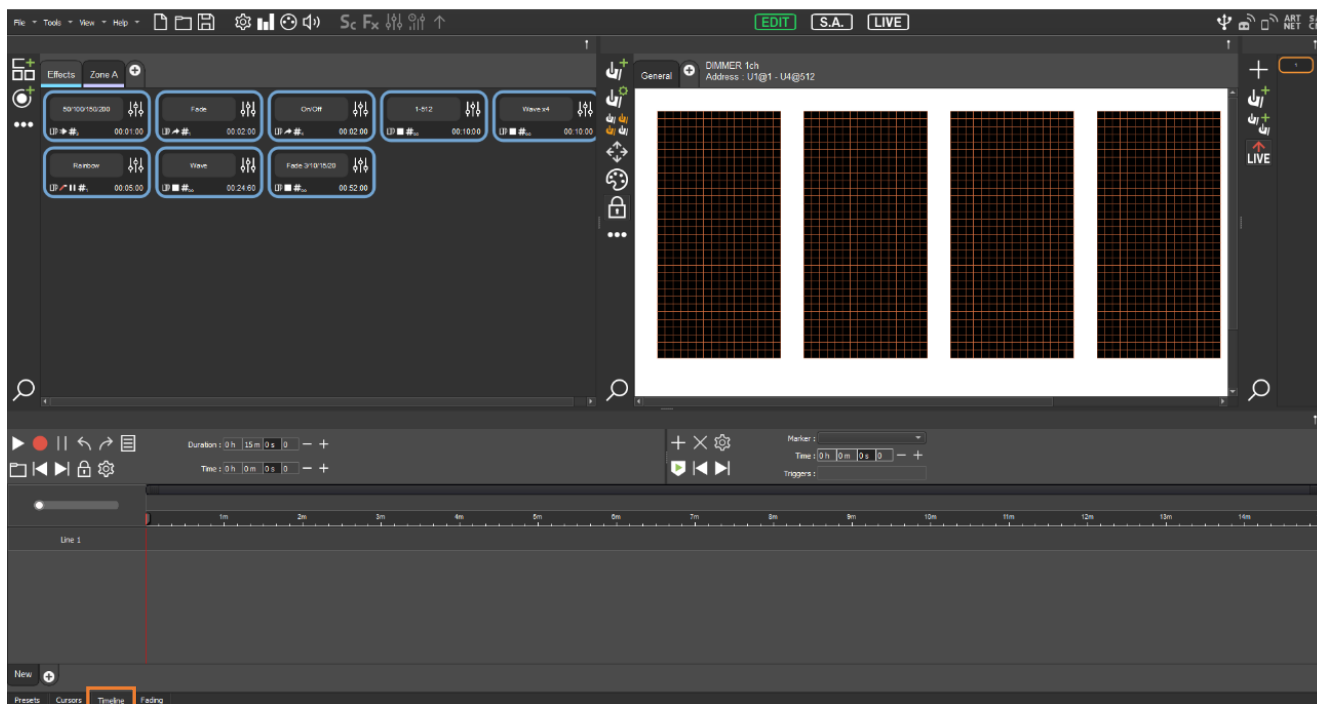
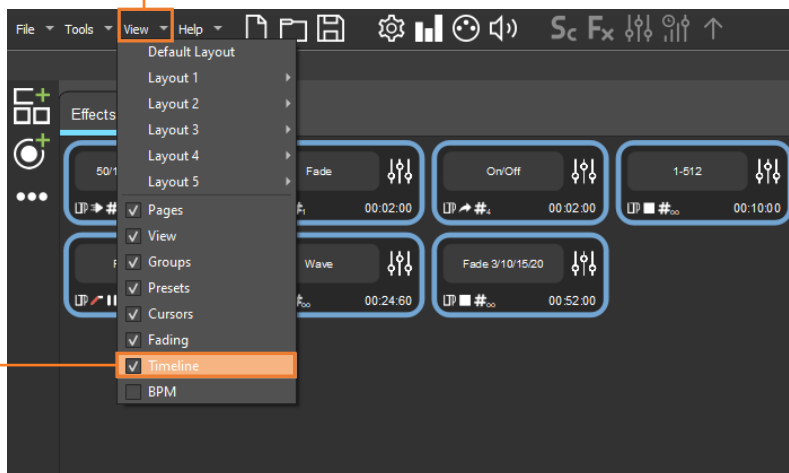

ACCESS TIMELINE

To access the timeline you need to activate the option in the view menu:

- 1- Click to View menu to access the windows selection

- 2- Select Timeline to add it to the software display



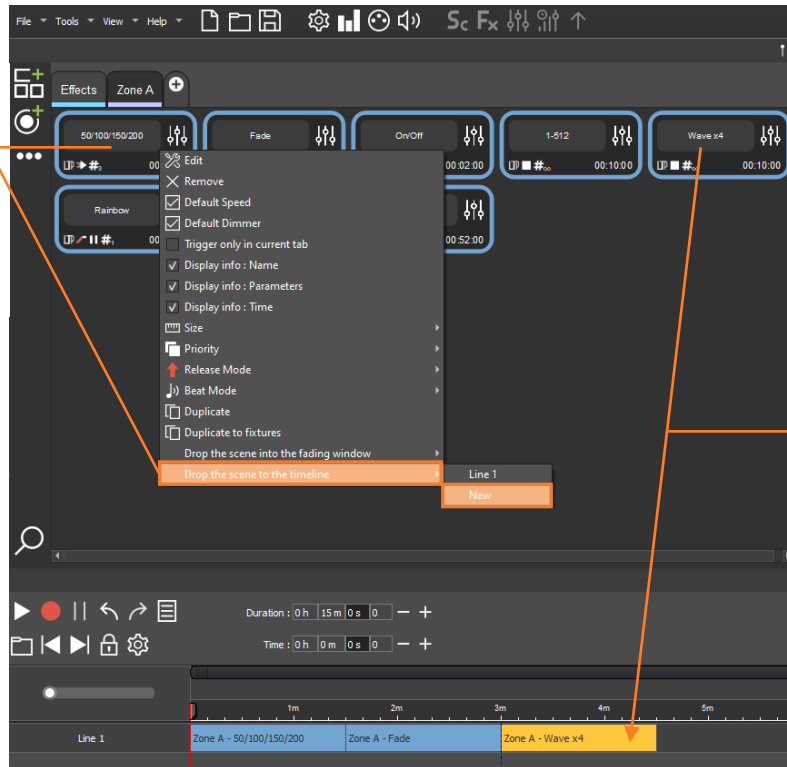
- 3- The Timeline Tab is added

CREATE THE TIMELINE

Add scenes to the Timeline

There is two way to add scenes to the timeline, with a right click or with the Drag and Drop

Right click on the scene you want to add, select Drop the scene to the timeline and the desired line



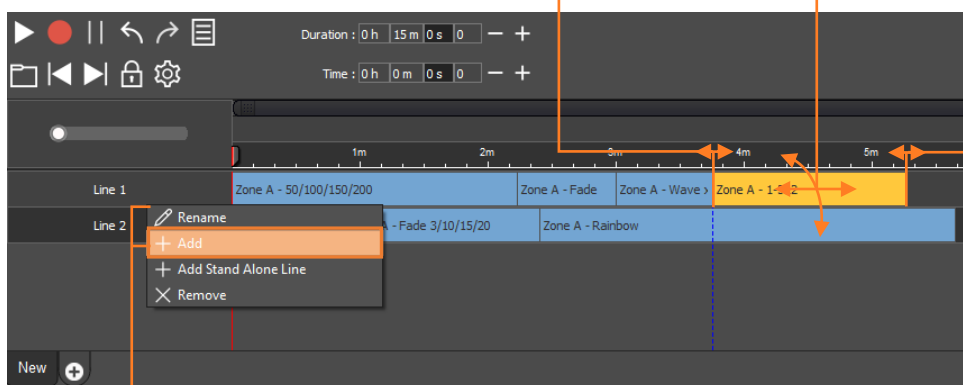
Keep pressing left click and Drag and Drop the desired scene in the timeline

You can adjust each block with the mouse.

Click and hold the mouse to adjust start

Click and hold to move the block

Click and hold the mouse to adjust end time

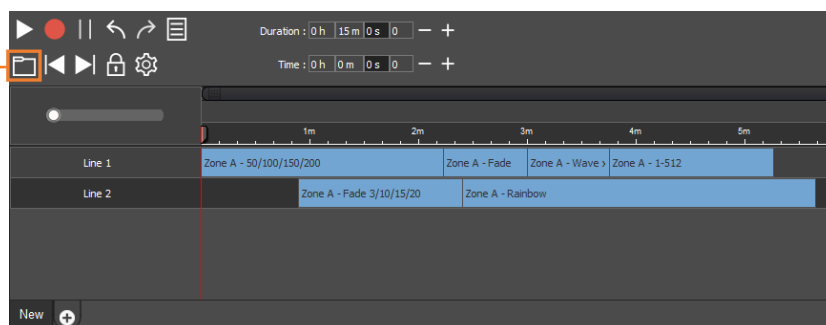


Right click in the Line and select + Add to add a new line

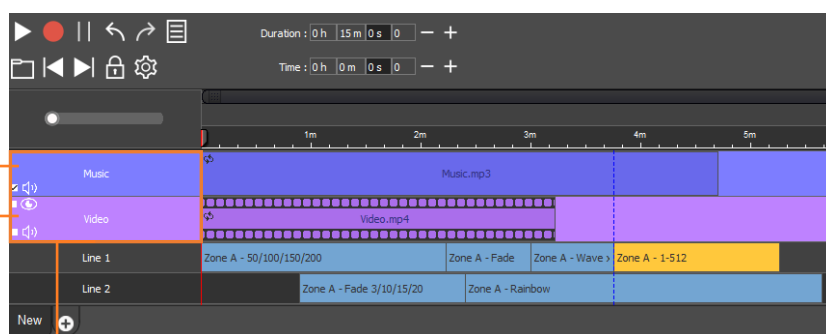
Import Medias files

The timeline allows you to insert audio and/or video blocks to synchronize scenes and triggers with music and video.

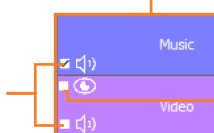
Click to the folder icon to add audio or video files from your computer



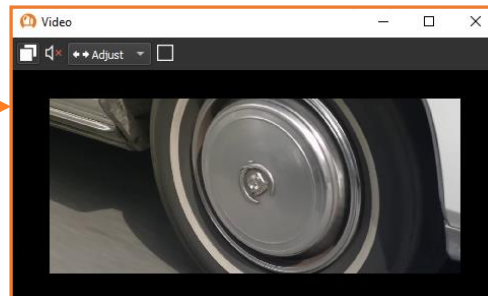
Music and Video lines are added to the timeline, it is possible to adjust it as scenes blocks



Check to play the audio on the selected line



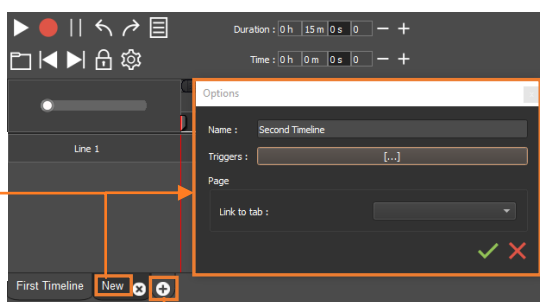
Check display the video player



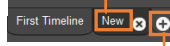
Rename and create many Timelines

It is possible to create many timelines and name each one.

Double click to the timeline tab name to open Options window and change the name

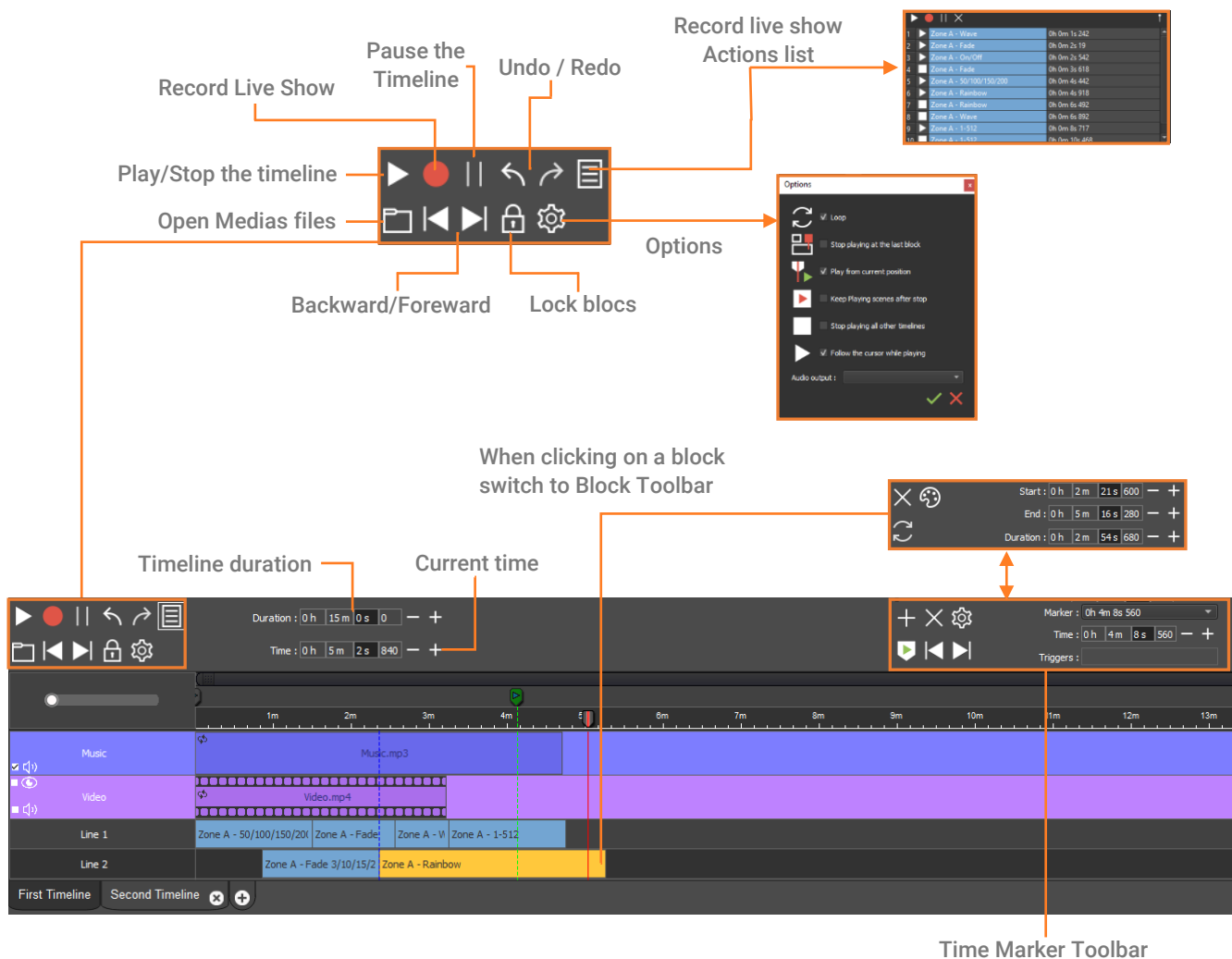


Click + to create a new timeline

Timeline toolbar description



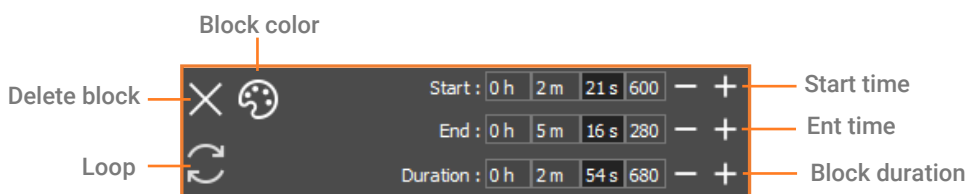
SYNCHRONISE A SHOW

To create a timeline with audio, video and lights synchronised you need to add media files and scenes in the timeline as explained before.

Blocks

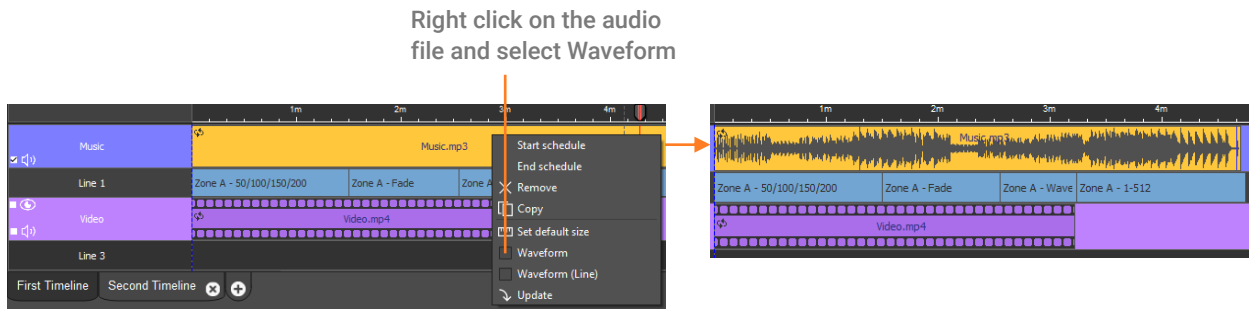
Scenes block setting is easy with the Toolbar block, you can choose exactly the duration of each blocks.

Waveform

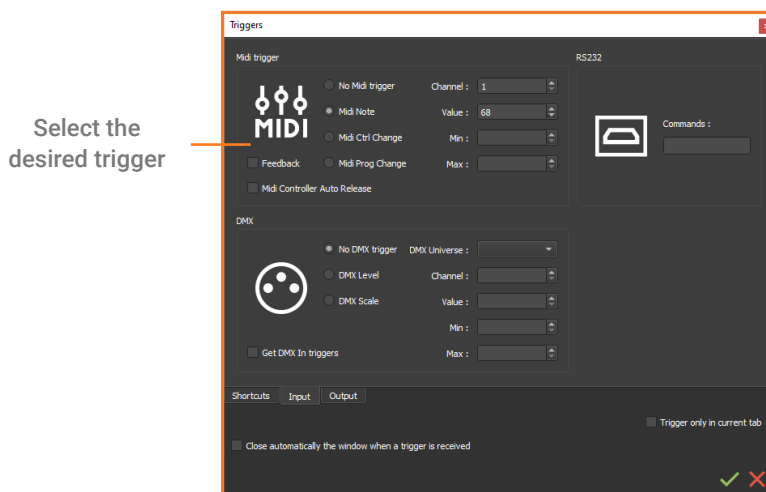
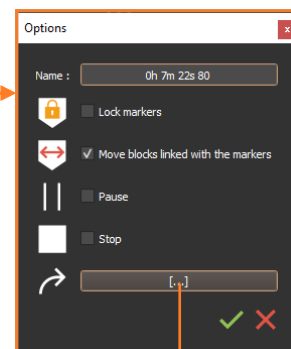
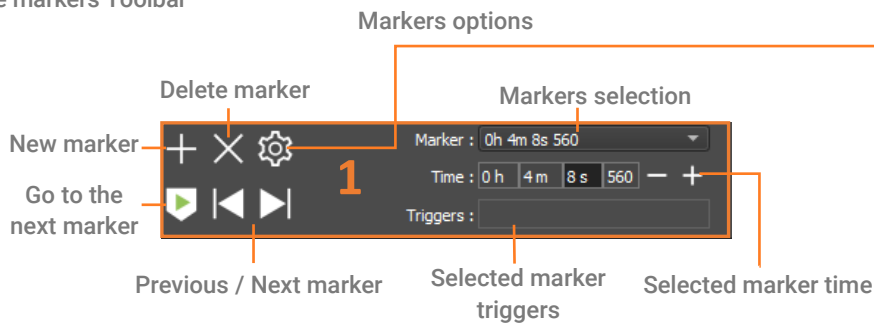
To easily synchronise the music and scenes block size you can display the audio file wave form:



Markers

Markers allows to navigate easily in the timeline, you can create many markers from the Time marker Toolbar. Then you can trigger each marker with Shortcuts, Dry contacts, Midi, DMX In...

PLAY AND TRIGGER TIMELINE

When the timeline is ready to use you can use different commands to control it.

General commands

- 1- Click to Tools and Options
- 2- Select the Commands tab
- 3- Select the desired trigger for each timeline commands

Buttons triggers

- 3- Right click on a Button trigger and select Edit
- 2- Select the timeline command you want to do when starting the Button Trigger trigger
